GRAHAM LANGAN: THE 6'0", 183-POUND PERFECT GAME & PBR-RANKED OUTFIELDER WITH POWER, SPEED, AND A BIG ARM FROM CHEROKEE HIGH SCHOOL

In Georgia's talent-rich 2028 class, Graham Langan has emerged as one of the most physically advanced and rapidly ascending young outfielders. Ranked by both Perfect Game and Prep Baseball Report, the Cherokee High School standout has developed into a high-ceiling prospect defined by explosive bat metrics, legitimate athleticism, and a next-level outfield arm.

At 6'0", 183 lbs, Langan brings the frame and tools of a future middle-of-the-order bat. His 94 mph exit velocity, 6.80 speed, and 86 mph outfield arm make him one of the more complete outfielders in his class — a rare blend of strength, speed, and projection that colleges value heavily.



THE BAT: POWER EMERGING EARLY — 94 MPH EXIT VELOCITY

Langan's bat is his calling card, and the numbers tell the full story.

His ability to produce loud, consistent contact with upper-tier bat speed has quickly elevated him onto recruiting boards.

Updated Hitting Metrics

- 94 mph exit velocity (max)
- High-level bat and hand speed
- Consistent hard-hit rates
- Efficient, explosive rotational movement

He hits with controlled aggression, stays inside the ball well, and drives it with authority. The ball comes off his bat differently — sharp, loud, and rising.

Scout Comment:

"Langan's 94 mph exit velocity at his age is exceptional. His bat speed and strength profile as future home-run power at the college level."



Now clocking at 6.80 in the 60, Langan pairs acceleration with long, powerful strides that translate perfectly to outfield play.

- 1.60 10-yard quickness
- 3.77 30-yard acceleration
- 20+ mph running velocity

He moves efficiently for his size, showing natural outfield range, body control, and closing speed. With continued growth and improved route discipline, he projects as a high-value defensive outfielder.

Scout Comment:

"He's a fast, strong mover with true athletic upside. His 6.8 speed or better will play extremely well at the next level."

THE ARM: 86 MPH FROM THE OUTFIELD — BIG ARM UPSIDE

Langan's most dramatic jump has come from the outfield, where he now touches 86 mph with smooth mechanics and carry on his throws.

This arm strength is:

- Above average for his class
- Highly projectable
- Sufficient for all three outfield positions
- Indicative of future upper-80s ability

His arm action is loose and free, with natural whip — ideal traits for future development.

Scout Comment:

"An 86 mph arm at his age is big. As he continues to build strength, this is easily a 90+ arm by his junior or senior year."

CHEROKEE HIGH SCHOOL'S NEXT ELITE OUTFIELD PROSPECT

Cherokee High School consistently produces tough, athletic, college-caliber players — and Langan is shaping up to be the next in line.

What separates him is not just his current performance but his **trendline**:



- His metrics keep climbing

- His arm strengthened significantly in a short timeframe
- His speed remains an asset at a stronger weight
