## JEREMIAH McGEACHY (2027): THE UNDERVALUED, TOOL-RICH MIDDLE INFIELDER WITH ELITE HITTING **ABILITY AND GAME-CHANGING ATHLETICISM**

In the Class of 2027 and being a young Class of 2027 talent, it is rare to find a player who combines elite speed, big-league level strength, and high-end hitting ability while still being relatively under the radar. Yet that is exactly what makes Jeremiah McGeachy one of Georgia's most intriguing — and most undervalued — infield prospects.

At 6'0", 195 lbs, the Ellenwood, Georgia native brings a physical presence uncommon for his age. McGeachy's current ranking simply does not reflect the true talent, tool set, or upward trajectory he possesses.

He is **under-ranked and massively undervalued** — and the data proves it.



## **ELITE SPEED THAT CHANGES THE GAME**

Few infielders in the country run like this.

## 6.55 60-yard dash

For a 195-pound athlete, these are special numbers. His burst, acceleration, and stride efficiency give him defensive range and offensive versatility that the rankings have yet to fully acknowledge.

### **Scout Comment:**

"Guys his size do not run 6.55. That is SEC-level speed. He's one of the best athletes in the 2027 Georgia class."

### THE BAT: ELITE HITTING ABILITY WITH SERIOUS POP (98 MPH EV)

McGeachy's hitting tools are easily among the best in his ranking tier — and arguably superior to many ranked significantly higher.

With a verified **98 mph exit velocity**, he demonstrates:

- True power projection
- Advanced bat speed



- Strength through contact
- Loud, consistent barrel impact
- Ability to drive the ball with carry

His PG exit velocity history shows tremendous growth, signaling a hitter who is developing faster than most of his class. He already hits like a college-level bat.

### **Scout Comment:**

"Jeremiah's pop is real. His bat speed and strength combination is elite for a middle infielder his age. His rankings are behind his tools."

### MULTI-POSITION DEFENSIVE VALUE WITH AN 83 MPH ARM

An 83 mph infield arm at his age puts him near the top percentile of 2027 infielders. He can play:

- **Shortstop:** athletic enough to handle the left side
- Second Base: quick release & smooth footwork
- Third Base: strength, size, and arm power
- Center Field: versatility when needed

His defensive ceiling is far higher than his current ranking suggests.

### **Scout Comment:**

"He's tool-rich defensively. The arm strength, foot speed, and glove actions all translate."

## WHY HE IS UNDERVALUED BY THE RANKINGS

Despite the exceptional measurable data, strong production, and rapid physical development, McGeachy remains ranked lower than his true ability level.

### **Reasons He Is Undervalued:**

- His tools place him in the **top-tier of 2027 athletes**, yet his ranking suggests mid-tier status.
- His **6.55 speed** is among the best in Georgia, regardless of position or class.
- His **98 mph exit velocity** matches or exceeds players ranked much higher.
- His 83 mph infield arm gives him multi-position value that many rankings don't fully reward.
- His physical maturation and athletic progression have outpaced his early evaluations.

### Simply put:

The rankings have not caught up to who Jeremiah is today.
